1 Scope

The General Terms and Conditions govern the legal relationship between nrw landesbuero tanz e. V., represented by its manager Heike Lehmké, Im Mediapark 7, 50670 Köln (hereinafter referred to as the Organiser) and the trade visitor (hereinafter referred to as Registered Visitor) as part of internationale tanzmesse nrw (event).

2 Implication, Service and Acceptance of Registration

2.1 Registration includes the following services:

- Access to the Agora
- Ticket reservation for the entire programme
- Bus shuttle service
- tanzmesse profile in account-protected area
- Entry in and receipt of the list of participants

Section 4 below provides further details on the above-mentioned services.

2.2. Booking

Registered Visitors can get registered for a fee of € 155 plus VAT (see section 5 below). Registration can be obtained online on the website of internationale tanzmesse nrw. Once the online registration is completed, the Registered Visitor enters into a contractual agreement with the Organiser, to which the Registered Visitor is bound until the beginning of the event period. The Organiser accepts the registration by sending a confirmation by e-mail.

3 Duration and Location of the Event

internationale tanzmesse nrw is held at the venue Agora at Bertha-von-Sutter-Platz, Düsseldorf and other venues in Düsseldorf and Krefeld.

internationale tanzmesse nrw takes place from 27/08/2024 to 31/09/2024.

4 Services Included in Registration

4.1 Access to the Agora

At the entrance, Registered Visitors are given a badge granting them free access to the Agora for the entire duration of the event. The Agora is open daily from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. from 29/08/2024 to 31/08/2024.

4.2 Tickets for Performance Programme

Registered Visitors are also entitled to book tickets for the performances programme, the discourse programme Talk & Connect and other events of internationale tanzmesse nrw free of charge. Tickets go on sale on 11 June 2024 (subject to change). Tickets for the programme must be booked in advance of the event online on the homepage of internationale tanzmesse nrw. The badge does not entitle the holder to attend any events.

Registered Visitors can book tickets for any events of the programme they are interested in only within one single and thus completed booking process. After completion of the one-time booking process, no further tickets can be booked.

Once the tickets have been booked, there is no entitlement to exchange tickets for other events.

4.3 Other Options for Participation

The badge entitles the Registered Visitors to participate in additional events within the framework of the internationale tanzmesse nrw for which no ticket booking is required. The Organiser reserves the right to make prior registration via the online portal of internationale tanzmesse nrw compulsory for certain events.

4.4 List of Participants for Networking

An essential service included in Registration is the networking of Registered Visitors. The online database of internationale tanzmesse nrw comprises a complete list of all Registered Visitors with their full names (first and last name); this list is made accessible to Registered Visitors.

Furthermore, the contact details (particularly name, e-mail, telephone number) of Registered Visitors will be stored in the database of internationale tanzmesse nrw for networking purposes; this data will be made accessible to all Registered Visitors (internal pool).

5 Fees

The net fee for Registration is € 155.

Fees are subject to VAT at the current rate of 7 %.

6 Payment Terms

6.1 Invoice

Any Registered Visitor shall receive an electronic invoice (including VAT) via database of internationale tanzmesse nrw. The Registered Visitor agrees to receiving the invoice in electronic form.

Fees shown are net prices in euro. Additionally, 7% statutory VAT is applied.

6.2 Due Date

Upon confirmation by the Organiser and dispatch of the corresponding invoice, the fee for registration shall be due immediately.

6.3 Payment Methods

The only payment methods accepted are via PayPal, credit card, or bank transfer.

All payments shall be made in euro. The date of payment shall be relevant for the exchange rate applied for foreign currencies. The Registered Visitor shall pay any bank or transfer fees and charges.

7 Organiser's Liability

Any liability for damage to or loss of property is excluded.

The Organiser, the Organiser's representatives and agents shall only be liable for damage of any kind suffered by Registered Visitors inside the event location in case of intent or negligence. Liability for injury to life, body and health shall remain unaffected.

8 Cancellation and Termination of Contract

8.1 Cancellation and Withdrawal by Registered Visitor

Cancellation is excluded. Any booking is binding.

Withdrawal from purchasing Registration is excluded.

8.2 Withdrawal/Cancellation by Organiser

The Organiser is entitled to withdraw from/cancel the contract if

- the full fee has not been received by the date specified in the invoice (the period must be at least 30 days), nor after the expiry of an extension granted to the Registered Visitor
- the Registered Visitor violates the safety concept or the house rules
- the Registered Visitor no longer fulfils the conditions for being granted admission or the Organiser subsequently becomes aware of reasons that would have justified non-admission if they had been known beforehand.

9 Force Majeure

If the event or parts of the event cannot be held for reasons of force majeure or for other reasons for which the Organiser cannot be held responsible, the Registered Visitors shall have no claims against the Organiser beyond the statutory provisions.

10 Cancellation Due to Pandemic

If the event has to be cancelled because of a pandemic, the statutory regulations shall apply.

11 Change of Programme

The programme is subject to change. Registered Visitors are required to inform themselves in advance about changes to the programme or starting times.

12 Admission

Admission to an event of the performance programme is only granted to holders of a valid ticket. The badge does not entitle the holder to attend any event of the programme without prior booking of a ticket. There is no entitlement to admission or re-admission after the start of the event.

13 Photo, Video and Sound Recordings

Registered Visitors are not permitted to take photos and to make video or audio recordings of any kind anywhere on the event premises at any time. In case of violation against this provision, the Organiser shall be entitled to confiscate the material.

The Organiser shall be entitled to make any kind of audio and video recordings as well as to take photos of the entire event, using them for PR and archiving purposes to promote the event and future events. The Registered Visitors agree that they may be recorded on video or audio and that these recordings may be published, broadcast and reproduced for the purposes mentioned above without any temporal or spatial restrictions and without any return (such as remuneration) other than the increase of their personal and artistic reach.

14 Domiciliary Rights

The Organiser shall exercise the domiciliary rights on the event premises. The house and ground regulations of the respective venue apply, which will be sent to any Registered Visitor on request.

15 House Rules

- 15.1 The behaviour of any Registered Visitor must in no way endanger, obstruct, harm, threaten or harass any other person.
- 15.2 Entering the stage, backstage, dressing room, rehearsal and storage areas is not permitted.
- 15.3 Mobile phones and other technical devices with acoustic signals and/or illuminated screens are to be switched off during events of the performance programme.
- 15.4 Instructions given by the staff must be followed without fail. In the event of non-compliance, a ban from the premises may be issued.
- 15.5 Registered Visitors must comply with the safety measures issued by the Organiser for the event.
- 15.6 Smoking is prohibited in all rooms.
- 15.7 Escape routes and emergency exits must be kept clear at all times.
- 15.8 The consumption of food and beverages brought to the event premises is not permitted.
- 15.9 Animals must not be brought to the event premises. The exception to this is guide dogs and other assistance animals.

16 Data Protection

- 16.1 The Organiser shall process the personal data provided by the Registered Visitors such as address, account details, telephone number, photos, video and audio recordings, parts of programme proposals, and e-mail address.

- 16.2 The collection and processing of the Registered Visitors' personal data shall be carried out for the purpose of executing the contract. In this respect, the data collection and data processing are based on GDPR Article 6 (1) point b, as well as on the Registered Visitor's consent (to photos for PR purposes), which is based on GDPR Article 6 (1) point a.
- 16.3 Furthermore, the purposes of data processing result from the respective statutory obligations of each party such as statutory retention periods and accountability to the tax authorities. In this respect, the corresponding data collection and processing are based on GDPR Article 6 (1) point c.
- 16.4 In addition, the purpose of data processing may result from the legitimate interests of one of the parties or third parties if and to the extent that the interests, fundamental rights and freedoms of the respective other party do not prevail. In this respect, the corresponding data collection and processing are based on GDPR Article 6 (1) point f.

17 Place of Jurisdiction and Applicable Law

The place of jurisdiction is Cologne, Germany.

Any legal relations between the Organiser and the Registered Visitor shall be governed by German law and the version of the General Terms and Conditions in German language, including supplements or restrictions as published on the website of internationale tanzmesse nrw and/or in the registration form, together with these GTC.

18 Entry into Force

These General Terms and Conditions shall enter into effect on 11/06/2024.

19 Severability Clause

If any provision of these General Terms and Conditions should be invalid, that shall not affect the validity of the remaining terms and conditions.
